

CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

OUR COMMITMENT TO THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN

Hostel Bearlog believes that no child or adolescent should experience any form of violence (physical, mental or sexual), neglect or exploitation. In accordance with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, we are committed to respecting and protecting all children and adolescents under the age of 18 living in our building, as well as all those who work or live in our surroundings, and ensuring that they are protected from all forms of abuse, exploitation and neglect.

We explicitly believe that:

- The well-being of children and adolescents is paramount.
- All children and adolescents under the age of 18 have the right to equal protection against abuse, neglect or exploitation, regardless of their age, disability, gender, race, religion or sexual orientation.
- Working with local child protection organizations, charities and law enforcement will ensure that our actions are strong and effective.

We will protect children and adolescents by:

- we will appreciate, listen to and respect them,
- We will teach our staff about this policy and the child protection process so that they:
 - pay attention to signs of child abuse, exploitation or neglect
 - know what to do to insure a child they suspect is in danger.
- we will promote our child protection policy to our suppliers, subcontractors and guests so that they also support our commitments,
- We will share our concerns about vulnerable children and adolescents with local security organizations and law enforcement agencies so that we always work for their benefit.
